Modules of the Workshop

5. Understanding about the various Research Designs
6. Differentiation between Qualitative and Quantitative Research Approaches.
7. Logic: Inductive & Deductive Inferences, Propositions, Premise & Conclusion.
8. Content Analysis, Narrative Inquiry, Discourse Analysis, etc.
9. Ethnographic Study – Narrative Ethnography, Observation, Case Study Method, etc.
10. Data Analysis – Documentation and Writing Qualitative Research
11. Knowledge about various statistical packages for Data Analysis
12. Developing a Research Proposal/Synopsis

Amkantak is situated 30 kms in the west of Pendra Road Railway Station (Chattisgarh) on Katni-Bilaspur track of South West Central Railway. Almost all the trains plying on this track stop here. It can be reached by bus from
